

Kittens should get a series of 2-3 FVRCP vaccinations starting when they are 7-8 weeks old. They should receive their series 3-4 weeks apart. All kittens should have at least one FVRCP a week before getting spayed or neutered. All cats over 4 months of age should have a rabies vaccine. All cats need an FELV/FIV test.
